George Bernard Shaw's comedy *Arms and the Man* is fully loaded - with charm and panache, dashing heroes and feisty damsels. The title, taken from Vergil's Aeneid: "Of arms and the man I sing" serves as a satiric tag for the play's thrust against romanticizing courage under fire. Arms and the Man contradicts the popular belief that soldiers are heroes who are inspired by patriotic sentiments, and presents warfare as a profession like any other. Notions of love and class are also turned upside down in this witty anti-romantic comedy of ideas, which takes the stage of the Frederic Wood Theatre by storm with a LIVE band playing all your favorite Bulgarian Folk Music hits!
